He also was a member of the Executive Committee of the Association for Medical Education in Europe (AMEE) from 2015-2018 and is a reviewer for numerous journals and institutions.

He received his Master of Medical Education (MME) degree at the University of Bern, Switzerland, and is also certified in Medical Informatics. Since 2004 he is Co-Director of the German Master of Medical Education (MME) program at Heidelberg University.
